This morning we welcome Joel Reichenbach, Corporate & Faith Relations Coordinator at Habitat for Humanity of Greater Indy. Joel worked in educational media for K-LOVE Radio before coming to Habitat. A graduate of Huntington University, he loves technology, board games, and music. CUMC works with other churches to build a home each fall. In addition to Habitat for Humanity, Castleton is involved in the following missions.

Mission Guatemala

CUMC has supported the mission originated by UMC Pastor Tom Heaton since its inception. We send work teams to help improve the quality of life for the people of Guatemala. Next trip 2020.

Food Pantry Support

CUMC supports The Sharing Place, The Community Cupboard of Lawrence Township and the Lawrence North student pantry with donations taken in each week.

Jail Ministries

A ministry for over 30 years, once a month church services are held inside the Marion County Jail. We provide Bibles, devotionals and more.

Metro Ministries

An outreach arm of the Central District of the UMC, they connect resources and ministries. CUMC provides funding for grants, jail ministries, and Fletcher Place Community Center through Metro Ministries.

Indiana Women's Prison

We host a Mother's Day Luncheon every April for women incarcerated at the Indiana Women's Prison and their children.

Pick-A-Bus

Each fall we fill backpacks with needed school supplies for children enrolled in the Family Preservation Program. Extra donations are shared with Crestview Elementary and Skiles Test Elementary.

Human Trafficking - Hope Center

Hope Center is an after-care program for women rescued from sex trafficking. This Christ-centered mission provides a safe place with food and shelter along with education and mental health services. April 7th between services, HOPE Center Indy and Ascent 121 will present ways to get involved and do something to help those who have been the victim of Human Sex Trafficking. A speaker from both organizations will be in Castleton's family life center at 10am (between services), on Sunday April 7, 2019.

Child Advocacy - CASA Volunteers

CUMC has a group of CASA. They work with Child Advocates of Marion County to be the voice of children in foster care.

Roberts Park UMC Soup's On

We assist in serving a hot meal to guests in downtown Indy on Sundays six times a year.

AHEPA 232 Senior Apartments

We assist our neighbors with cleaning and general maintenance needs while visiting with the residents. Join us next Saturday, February 16 when we will meet in the lobby of Ahepa, 7355 Shadeland Station Way at 9am.

Share-LT

Share is a non-denominational outreach of CUMC and others who want to create space for teens 12-18 to flourish beyond school hours.

Community Cupboard Of LT

This Lawrence Township food pantry serves residents in need of assistance. CUMC was a founding partner in this mission and continues to support it through food donations, volunteers and Faith Promise dollars.

Crestview School of Communications

We support our neighborhood school with backpacks and school supplies, Christmas outreach to families and volunteer help for events.

IHN/Family Promise

Four times a year, we partner with Family Promise/IHN to house children and their caregivers who are facing homelessness. Many volunteers are needed to drive, feed, and spend the night with these guests.
