CMC Talks Meal Helpers

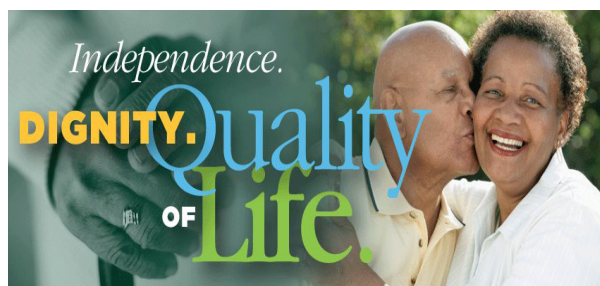
